

Development of Trewint Playing Field

The Parish Councils held a meeting on the 31st March to discuss the possibility of increasing the facilities at the playing field at Trewint Lane. The decision to explore some options came from the results of our Parish Plan that identified the need for more recreational opportunities for our parishioners (Old and Young).

At the meeting it was agreed to draw up a plan to

- 1 Replace the existing buildings (with exception of the Pre-school) with a new build that would still retain the present users i.e. Brownies Scouts and Football club but have extra space that could be used for other recreational activities.
- 2 Add to outdoor equipment in the form of exercise equipment for all ages
- 3 Create a skate or cycle park for older children
- 4 In conjunction with the wishes of the football club look to install an all weather surface that could be used for basket ball netball etc.
- 5 Lay a hard surface track around the perimeter for use by smaller children with cycles or general exercise

All the above are ideas and at this early stage we are keen to have the views of our Parishioners. We hope to be able to apply for funding from the Queen Elizabeth Jubilee fund, but obviously this is a large project that will need lots of fundraising. Both Highlands and Lowlands Parish Councils are agreed that we are lucky to have such a large piece of land at our disposal and that currently it is not used to its full Potential. In the near future we hope to post around the Parish an Initial plan for consultation but in the meantime if you feel you would like to comment or indeed get involved we would like to hear from you, we really would like this to be a Parish Project that we can all be proud of.
